

# Spelling Success

Try different ways of learning so they really stick!

<p><b>SMALL WORDS</b> Find all the small words you can inside your spelling words.</p>	<p><b>SPELLAMADOODLE</b> Take your pencil for a walk around your paper to create a doodle. Then write your word end to end along the times.</p>	<p><b>SYNONYMS</b> Find synonyms for each of your spelling words (Synonyms are word that mean the same)</p>	<p><b>WORDADOODLE</b> Draw a simple picture of the word. Then write your word end to end around the outline.</p>	<p><b>SPELLING RHYMES</b> Create a spelling rhyme for a spelling word (Mnemonic) e.g. Claws And Tail</p>
<p><b>LETTER CARDS</b> Create some letter cards and construct your words using these letter cards.</p>	<p><b>CLOZE STORY</b> Challenge yourself to write a short story containing all of your spelling words.</p>	<p><b>WHO AM I?</b> Create a 'Who am I?' for one of your spelling words.</p>	<p><b>ANAGRAM</b> Get a friend or adult to give you the letters for your word jumbled up. Can you put them in the right order?</p>	<p><b>ROGUE</b> Get a friend/adult to give you the letters for your word jumbled up but with one or more rogue letter. Can you put them in the right order?</p>
<p><b>TYPE OR TEXT</b> Type all of your spelling words on the computer or text to a friend/parent. You can even email them or work with a friend on messenger (Be safe online!)</p>	<p><b>SIGN YOUR WORDS</b> Find a sign-language alphabet (try the internet). Use sign language to sign your words!</p>	<p><b>FANCY LETTERS</b> Use old magazines, catalogues or newspapers to cut out letters and glue them down to spell your words!</p>	<p><b>MEMORY GAME</b> Make pairs of word cards. Flip them over and try to match the pairs!</p>	<p><b>PIPE CLEANER OR WOOL WORDS</b> use pipe cleaners and bend and form to make letters used to write out the words. Or supply some wool and scissors and snip to create letters to spell out the words.</p>
<p><b>ABC ORDER</b> Write your words in alphabetical order. Then write them in reverse alphabetical order</p>	<p><b>CHEERLEADER CHANT</b> Give me an S, give me a P, give me an E, give me an L, give me a L - what's that spell? SPELL!</p>	<p><b>READ, COVER, WRITE CHECK</b> Read the word, cover it over, write it down (without looking), check your word.</p>	<p><b>COLOURFUL WORDS</b> Use two different colour pens to write your words; one colour for the consonants and another for vowels.</p>	<p><b>ENERGETIC SPELLING</b> Spell out words aloud whilst skipping, bouncing a ball, play hopscotch....get moving!</p>
