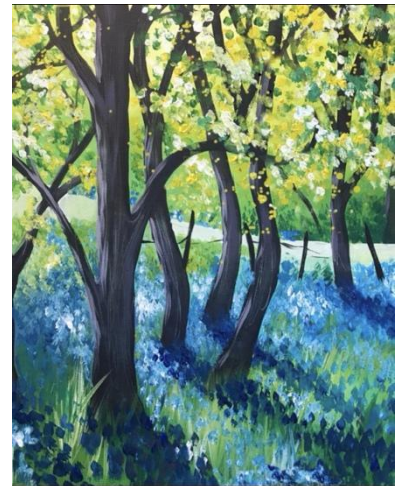
Brush Party – 1st May 🎨
