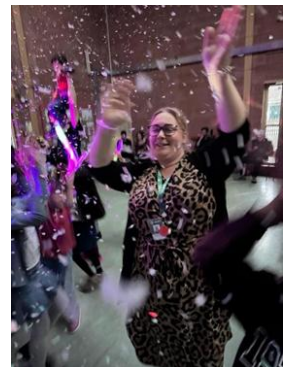
Art Showcase

Over the Easter break, a new partition wall was installed at the community end of the school. Many of you may have spotted the progress during the school disco. We are currently awaiting the installation of the door, which will complete the project. Once finished, this improvement will allow us to open the main school corridor more fully, making movement between the hall, The Lookout, and the main corridor much easier. Importantly, it will also support our ability to operate as a secure site when the community centre is in use during the school day.

Looking ahead to the summer, RET are developing plans for an updated and refreshed Library in the Ladygrove Room. This is an exciting project that will significantly enhance our reading curriculum. The new partition wall, allowing this part of the school to remain fully open, means the Ladygrove Room can be dedicated to the library. We look forward to sharing more details and plans for the refurbishment as they become available.
