Year 5 Trip to Didcot Railway Museum

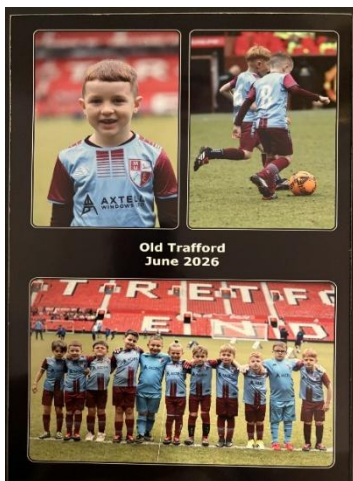
